Do Smoke Alarms Save Lives?

The presence of a working smoke alarm in a home reduces the risk of dying in a fire by 50%. Approximately 890 lives could be saved annually if all homes had working smoke alarms.

*Please place close attention while cooking. If you burn your food and the smoke enters the hallway it will trigger the building's smoke alarm system. Open your lanai door to air out smoke, not your front entrance door.
